An extension of time for inspection and for the making of submissions/observations is being provided so as to ensure full and effective public participation as it has come to the National Transport Authority's attention that the date for the end of the inspection period and the date by which objections were said to be required to be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála in relation to the associated Templeogue/Rathfarnham to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme Compulsory Purchase Order 2023 were incorrect on the non-statutory Site Notices which had been erected at certain locations along the Templeogue/Rathfarnham to City Centre Core Bus Corridor Scheme. These non-statutory notices also referred to the incorrect date for the making of submissions/observations on the Environmental Impact Assessment Report and the Natura Impact Statement. This discrepancy has now been rectified and all site notices have been replaced to reflect the extension of the consultation period beyond the **20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 to 15<sup>th</sup> August 2023.**
